They can seriously do that.

So... If you're gonna stock up on Old-Label Paraquat/gramoxone, be sure *Not* to have any New-Label on the Farm.

** Yup ..The Original-Drop-Dead-Date for us to sell off all existing "Old-Label" Paraquat product *was* 11-14-2019 *but*the EPA graciously extended that Final-Sale-Date to 11-14-20 ...

And Yes... the New Rules-Regs-Restrictions all apply to all of the Generic Paraquat Formulations just as much as the "'Gramoxone" Branded products.

And Yes... I do make a big issue out of this Big Issue.... Paraquat is/should be a big part of your Herbicide program...as Glyphosate is really quite dangerous to Blues & all Cane & Bramble Crops, and Young Tree-Fruit Plantings.
