overwintering orchard critters begin to get a wee bit restless at development thresholds of only 44-45'F...

* Planning to thin your Galas harder this season for better fruit size ? - Good plan !!

- The math is pretty simple: earlier Gala thinning = larger Gala fruit size
- And the most cost-effective way to thin them harder for better fruit size is to dormant prune them harder.
- Chemical thinners alone just can't knock enough fruitlets off of this highly productive apple variety
- You'd be way ahead to go back out soon and dorman re-prune bearing Gala trees some more for a second time than to hit them repeatedly with chemical thinning agents or to hand-them more aggressively.
- If your older Gala trees look neat and tidy now all full of droopy old fruiting wood, they will once again be extremely difficult to chemically thin and fruit size will remain iffy.
- Go back out and shorten up some pendant fruiting wood to both reduce total potential crop load and remove flower clusters which won't size well to begin with. It'll make your chemical thinning program look

* NEW and upcoming scab fungicides for apples -

- Miravis(Syngenta) SDHI fungicide is effective vs. apple scab, powdery mildew and summer diseases and is labeled for use in New York state in 2020.
- Kenja 400SC(Summit Agro) SDHI fungicide is labeled vs. scab and powdery mildew(suppression)- and is registered for use in New York state.
- Cevya(BASF) DMHI/SI fungicide is effective vs. scab, powdery mildew and summer diseases. Unfortunately it is not yet registered for use in New York state.
- Like older SIs and SDHIs, these new materials should also be tank-mixed with protective fungicides
